Biking on the island is safe and easy, thanks to the flat landscape and multitude of paths and sand roads. After renting your bike, follow any instructions our friendly staff give you. Bula Bikes offers a free Map on what to see and do on our island in both English and Chinese.

Please note bikes are for cycling around Plantation Island Resort only and are not permitted at Musket Cove.

Boat Protocol

While staying at the Resort, you may be approached by local Villagers to take a sightseeing trip on one of their boats. We would like to inform you that this is not recommended as these boats may not be surveyed by the Maritime & Safety Authority of Fiji (MSAF) and in most cases, do not meet safety standards. Even though these trips may sound tempting and cheap, they should not

be taken. Should you be offered any of these trips, could you kindly report it to Management. Plantation Island Resort will not accept responsibility for any accidents or mishaps if resort guests use these private boating facilities.

Cats & Birds

Malolo Lailai Island is home to some domestic cats that are collared. Others are wild and may be a nuisance to guests. Please assist in our endeavors for a peaceful co-existence with these animals by not feeding “kitty” and friends.

Checkout Time

Check out time is strictly at 10am, should you wish to extend beyond 10am, please contact Reception on the day of departure.

Day rooms are available subject to availability and will incur a fee.

Church Services

The Church has a service at 11am every Sunday for 1 hour. It is attended by team members and all guests are welcome to join the service. Please meet at reception at 10.30am to be escorted to the Church.

Currency Exchange

Foreign Currency and Travellers Cheques can be exchanged at daily-published rates with our Cashiers Reception. We regret that we are unable to accept personal cheques.

Developments

You may discover a few locations around the resort where maintenance work is being done to improve our facilities. We apologise for any inconvenience.

Work will be carried out between 8am-5pm daily and disturbance will be kept to a minimum. Please see Reception if you have any queries

Directory of Services

Diving

Subsurface Dive operates the diving on Plantation Island Resort. For more information on dive sites, PADI Certification Courses & Costs please visit www.fijidiving.com or contact the Booking & Tours Office directly.

Dress

We encourage a relaxed casual atmosphere and invite you to feel comfortable at all times, however we would ask you not to sit on the dining lounge chairs with wet towels/swimming costumes. Please also wear appropriate attire as a courtesy to fellow diners. Tank Tops for men are not permitted, and Footwear is required at Black Coral Grill. Topless sunbaking is not permitted at Resort Pools and Beaches.

Live Entertainment

Our resident string band performs nightly in Copra Restaurant during dinner.

Then move to Brigham Bar for fun activities each evening, followed by a DJ or Live Band until late.

Guest Accounts

Resort guests can charge all purchases at Plantation Island Resort to their room account or pay via credit card at all outlets.

Please settle your accounts with Reception at least one hour before your departure.

The resort has a limit of FJ\$1000 (one thousand) dollars which can be charged back to your room account. Guests will be notified when this limit is reached and request that it is cleared before further charges can be made.

Plantation room charge facilities are NOT available at Lomani Island Resort & Spa or Musket Cove Resort.

Holiday Hints

Please ensure you apply sunscreen and drink plenty of water to protect yourself against the tropical sun. If you are

undertaking unsupervised watersports, please contact the Activities team and advise them of your plans.

Contact our Medical Clinic to treat cuts or severe insect bites as in the tropics with our humidity, they can lead to infection. Medical first aid kits are available at all outlets, please ask a staff member for assistance.

Insects / Animals

Being situated on a tropical island, it is not uncommon to see occasional mosquitoes, bugs, spiders, lizards and land crabs. Please do not be alarmed, none are poisonous & they will not harm you. We suggest that you close your room doors at sunset to keep insects out. We also recommend applying a tropical strength insect repellent (available for purchase at the Resort Retail Shops) at dusk/early evening to prevent mosquito and sand-fly bites.

Keys

Please present your key to Reception for a refundable deposit when leaving the Resort.

Laundry

The Guest Laundry is situated behind the Reception and is equipped with automatic washing machines and dryers. These are all token operated and tokens are available for purchase from Reception. Washing powder and pegs can be purchased from Reception or Island Traders.

Medical Centre

Our Clinic is located next to the Retail Outlet precinct and opens from 8am – 1pm and 2pm – 5pm daily. A 24 hour emergency service is also available.

Please contact Reception by dialling 0 and they will arrange assistance.

Extra fees applies after hours.

Pools

There are four swimming pools located throughout the resort. All pools are open during daylight hours, however they are chlorinated at night and are not suitable for swimming during this time. Please adhere to the pool rules in place. There are no life guard attendants on duty at any time. For Pool locations please refer to the Resort map.

Power Supply

Electricity current is 240 volts AC-50 Cycles. Outlets are the same as Australian/New Zealand.

Reception Hours

Reception operates 24 hours, seven days a week. Please dial 0 if you require any assistance.

Room Servicing

In an effort to reduce our impact on the environment, your room will be serviced every second day. If you would like additional towels or anything further please contact Reception.

Security Boxes

In-room safes are available in all Guest Rooms. The Resort accepts no responsibility or liability for any valuable items which are not deposited for safe keeping.

Spa Treatments

Senibua Spa is available 7 days a week between 9am - 6pm for treatments. Bookings can be made at the Booking Office or by emailing spa@plantationisland.com Spa closes at 8pm daily.

Strollers

Strollers for toddlers are available for hire from Reception.

Telephone

Tipping

Tipping is not customary in Fiji, however if you feel you have received great service, the Staff have an "Appreciation Fund" located in Reception.

Umbrellas

There are two umbrellas available in each room, please ensure they are returned to the room before your departure. If there is a need for more, they are available for hire at Reception for \$25 each.

Water

We are committed to providing safe and environmentally conscious drinking water. Please note that water from our taps is desalinated and not suitable for drinking, although it is chlorinated and safe for bathing and brushing your teeth. You will be provided with a complimentary bottle of water upon check-in. To obtain additional fresh drinking water, please see the below options:

1. Be eco-friendly and save money by refilling your bottle at the complimentary water refill stations at Tavola Bar, Snack Bar or Coco Hut.
2. Aqua Pacific bottled water is sold at a subsidised price for F\$3.50 per litre from Brigham Bar or Tavola Bar.

Wheelchairs

Are available for hire from Reception.

WiFi

Complimentary Standard WiFi is now available in the public areas which include Copra Restaurant, Brigham Bar, Black Coral, Tavola Restaurants and Reception area.

If you require WiFi in your room, you can purchase a WiFi code package from Reception using a credit card or room charge.

There is a toll free support line available which guests can call directly for support on 777 9800 (note dial '9' for a line out before the number).

Coral Conservation

Through partnership with Corals for Conservation the resort aims to create a network of super coral outplanting sites which will be dotted across the Outer Barrier Reef to restore the reef to what it once was before mass bleaching events and other threats eradicated the living corals in the area.

There are five restoration sites where the corals grown in the nurseries were placed on degraded sections of reef to restart the process of reef building. We consistently test and adjust our methods to try and select the most thermally tolerant corals.

Guests can get involved!

Guests can find the weekly schedule near the boat shed and also sign up there. Some activities have limits on the number of guests that can attend so early registration is encouraged.

Snorkelling

Snorkelling gear is complimentary if returned by 5pm the same day. A \$5 fee applies per day if you wish to keep the set overnight. Extra care must be taken not to stand on the coral when snorkelling as this could damage the reef. If you are just learning to snorkel, our Activities team would happily give you some tips. Snorkelling lessons are available at 9.30am daily.

Child Minding Services

FJD \$15.00 per hour per child and it's paid directly to the Nanny by cash only. There are No Room Charges for Nanny Service. A minimum of 3 consecutive hours per booking is required. Maximum of 2 children per babysitter. If the nanny service is booked and is extended during meal times, than meals are to be provided for the babysitter.

The Island Nanny Service

This is a 24 hour service for which there is a daily rate of FJ\$150 per child, maximum 2 children. Accommodation and meals must be provided for the nanny in addition to this rate. To facilitate this, it is recommended that two inter-connecting Studio Garden Bures be booked for the family with the adults sleeping in one bure and the children with the nanny in the other. If the family does not require the nanny to sleep over-night, then regular accommodation may be utilised with this service. The Island Nanny Service maybe pre-booked or arranged upon arrival at reception.

Food & Beverage

Restaurant Bookings: Due to high demand it is recommended that you visit the Booking Office (next to Brigham Bar) to reserve a table for dinner at Tavola or Black Coral Restaurants. Tables are always available however at Copra Buffet Restaurant. Booking Office is open 8am-8pm daily.

Environmental Initiatives

Water Usage

Water scarcity is a recognised global problem, and it is certainly a challenge on Malolo Lailai Island. At Plantation Island Resort, we do everything we can to conserve water and there are a number of ways that you can help during your stay with us.

Turn off Tap – Did you know that keeping the tap on whilst brushing your teeth can use up to 800 litres of water per room per month? Please help us by turning off the tap whilst you are in the process of brushing your teeth.

Beach/Pool Towels – Whilst we allow guests to change their pool towels every day, we recommend that you only return and replenish pool towels once every 2 days. This helps minimise washing and water usage.

Room Towels – You can help us conserve water by not getting the towels in your room washed every day. If you would like for your towels to be changed, please leave them on the floor.

Room Servicing – In an effort to reduce our impact on the environment, your room will be serviced every second day. If you would like additional towels or anything further please contact Reception.

Electricity Usage

Plantation Island Resort is located on an isolated island and all electricity at the Resort is generated using diesel power. Whilst we are working to implement more environmentally friendly power sources, you can help us minimise electricity usage during your stay. Please remember to turn off all the lights, fans and air-conditioners when you leave the room, even if it is for a few hours.

Marine Environment

Please assist us in protecting our marine environment by not standing on coral while snorkeling. Please also take care in not removing marine animals or coral from the water. In an effort to protect the islands Marine Environment, a restriction has been implemented on fishing around the island. There is no fishing allowed from off the beach, jetty or off any immediate facilities on the Resort. The restriction will allow marine life to re-populate and also protect the coral for future guests to enjoy.

Say No to Plastic

At Plantation Island Resort, we've cut out a number of unnecessary plastic from the premises. From straws for your cocktail to bags for your souvenirs, you'll no longer be offered these non-reusable plastics on your stay with us. Instead, paper straws will be available from our bars and restaurants upon request.

If you bring inflatable beach or pool toys to enjoy on your holiday, we ask that you please deflate them, fold them up and take them back with you to your home. Most plastic do not biodegrade and there is a high risk of damaging Fiji's precious environment.

Recycling

Please assist in recycling your used paper, cardboard, plastic or glass bottles and cans as this will assist us in the reduction of our landfill waste. Dispose of your rubbish thoughtfully in the bins provided.
